Your Child's School Report - advice and guidance

All S1-3 school reports have been issued to pupils and over the next 2 weeks we will be encouraging our young people to reflect on their report and begin to establish some targets to work towards over the coming months. At the back of each report is a reflection sheet with all your child's subjects listed on the left hand side. We would encorage you to discuss the report with your child and support them in establishing some targets for each of their subject areas. Your child can then bring the sheet into the school for use in their house assembly or PSE class where they will be able to add it to their profiles. By encouraging young people to reflect on their learning in this way and develop their understanding of where they are in their learning, we hope that young people will develop effective strategies that they can take forward into the Senior Phase of school.

British Council School Award

St. Margaret's Academy has been awarded the British Council's prestigious International Award 2019-2022. This is the 20th year of this award so an excellent time to be recognised for all of our International efforts.

The project began in 2016 following an eTwinning conference in Madrid when Mrs Godley began working with a team of International Teachers from all over Europe to develop an eTwinning project 'en los zapatos' meaning 'in their shoes'. Through an extensive exchange of information the lives of school students in different European countries were compared and contrasted. Of significant interest was the use of digital technologies. The project has generated much interest and is now used by many eTwinners across Europe.

A further development of the project entitled 'Brexit-what now' (which examined the possible effects of Brexit on our society) was produced in 2018 and this involved our S5 cohort. The project was entered into the eTwinning Maps competition winning £500 of Amazon vouchers for our school.

Due to the wide range of international activities being delivered within the school, including our recent Norwegian visit, ESOL teaching, celebrating Christmas around the globe, Shanty towns, Mother Tongue other Tongue, Rights Respecting schools and various International visits that our school partakes in each year, it became clear that a great deal of excellent work was being undertaken. An application was therefore made under The British Council's 'International Award Scheme'. It was with much excitement that we learned in recent weeks that our school has been awarded the highest accolade that the British Council makes, namely full international accreditation.

This is indeed a major achievement for the school and huge congratulations must be given to all those involved over the past few years. Mrs Godley will represent the school at the awards ceremony in London on 25th November.

Well done to everyone who has contributed in this magnificent achievement.
