1. STAFFING



We continue to invest in a Family Link Worker who liaises with our families to provide additional support such as uniform and providing assistance in accessing local supports. These links are helping families have a stronger connection the school and in turn positively impacting attendance.

2. LITERACY & NUMBERACY

Baseline numeracy assessments will be carried out around number confidence in order to target learners at risk of not achieving L4 outcomes. Literacy & numeracy postholders to use baseline assessment data to identify pupils at risk of not achieving expected outcomes



3. PUPIL LEADERSHIP



Having established links with charity Columba 1400 last session, we will continue to develop our pupil leadership through Leadership Academies, a revised Pupil Parliament and courses within Wellbeing classes to promote values-based leadership.

4. HEALTH & WELLBEING

Our new Pupil Parliament are leading plans to use a Participatory Budget in order to improve young people's experience. This includes plans for more social seating around the school and more drinking water outlets.



5. COST OF THE SCHOOL DAY



We have invested in our Uniform Hub and Breakfast Club. All young people in the target group will have accessed the REACH breakfast club room and all parents of target group pupils to feel an increased sense of belonging to the school.
